## *Put Your Guns Up: Analyzing Texas' Open Carry Laws and Active Shooter Response Training*

**Analyzing Texas's Open Carry Laws:** The new legislation authorizing holders of concealed handgun licenses to openly carry their holstered handguns went into effect on January 1, 2016. However, this is still much confusion over what the law does and does not allow and what rights business owners have with regards to preventing guns to be carried onto their premises. Attorney Jim Walsh, a shareholder at Walsh Gallegos Trevino Russo & Kyle, P.C. will review current and pending litigation and what it means for both private and public entities.
